**Computer Training**

Seventeen of our older boys are currently enrolled in a computers training and certification course. Classes started in September and will continue for 14 months. The boys attend the three-hour course each Saturday.

The staff at the Bolivia Life Center orphanage secured a grant to help with the costs of the training. The class was made available to the boys in the upper two dormitories. The ones who chose to participate signed a contract with the BLC to work three hours a week in exchange for their tuition. So far, the boys have helped paint, clean and repair things around their home. The boys are learning so much, academically and about responsibility, through this experience.

At the end of the course, the boys will receive three certificates: basic computer software, hardware repair and technical English. We hope you will share in our pride of the amazing young men our boys are growing into.
